PROJECT OVERVIEW

OBJECTIVE

28 days of excellence was created out of a need for representation in black and brown spaces. 28 days is more than a career fair, its a life fair. It serves as a way to connect school age students to people and careers in every field of life. 28 days also curates authentic conversations around harsh topics.

This years theme is Hustle and Motivate and its purpose will be to highlight different millennials in Detroit during black history month. The goal is too shed a light on a few amazing individuals in the city that are making an impact both locally and nationally.

HOW SPEAKERS & SCHOOLS ARE SOURCED?

- Mentors are chosen through a volunteer application process. In special cases mentors request a specific school based on relationship (alumni, age range, school type..). We seek out mentors with unconventional jobs (artists, You-Tubers, entrepreneurs) and successful people with or without college degrees.
- Schools are sourced through the DPSCD database and by writing it, with a preference for middle and high schools. Schools are then given a form to fill and are then selected based on availability.

PROGRAMING STYLE

WE OFFER TED STYLE CONVERSATIONS FOR AUDTORIUM AND CLASSROOM SETTINGS.

PANEL STYLES: (EACH PANEL IS MODERATED WITH PRESELECTED QUESTIONS AND AUDIENCE SOURCED QUESTIONS.)

- Mental health Panel; A group of 6-10 Mental health professionals and Media Influencers talking about their journeys and ways to self-care. Living as a teenager with mental health.
- Adulting Panel; A group of 6-10 people that will talk through the perils of life and the common mistakes taken by young people.
- Financial Literacy Panel: A group of 6-10 people will talk about credit scores, loans, paying bills, opening bank accounts and more...
- STEM & Career panel: A group of 6-10 professionals representing one field of the professional sector from lawyers to engineers.
- **Entrepreneur Panel:** A group of 6-10 millennial entrepreneurs that will talk about proper business practices as well as also talking about the pitfalls that come with this line of work.
- Living as a man in America: A panel of 6-10 MEN with the guidance of a moderator will have an open dialogue conversation about living like a man and what comes with it.
- Living HER life: A panel of 6-10 WOMEN with the guidance of a moderator will have an open dialogue conversation about living like women and what comes with it.

THE BREAKDOWN

The speakers will also be given the opportunity to be mentors and build that bond with the students over the course of mentor speed dating portion, and their information is provided to all in attendance.
